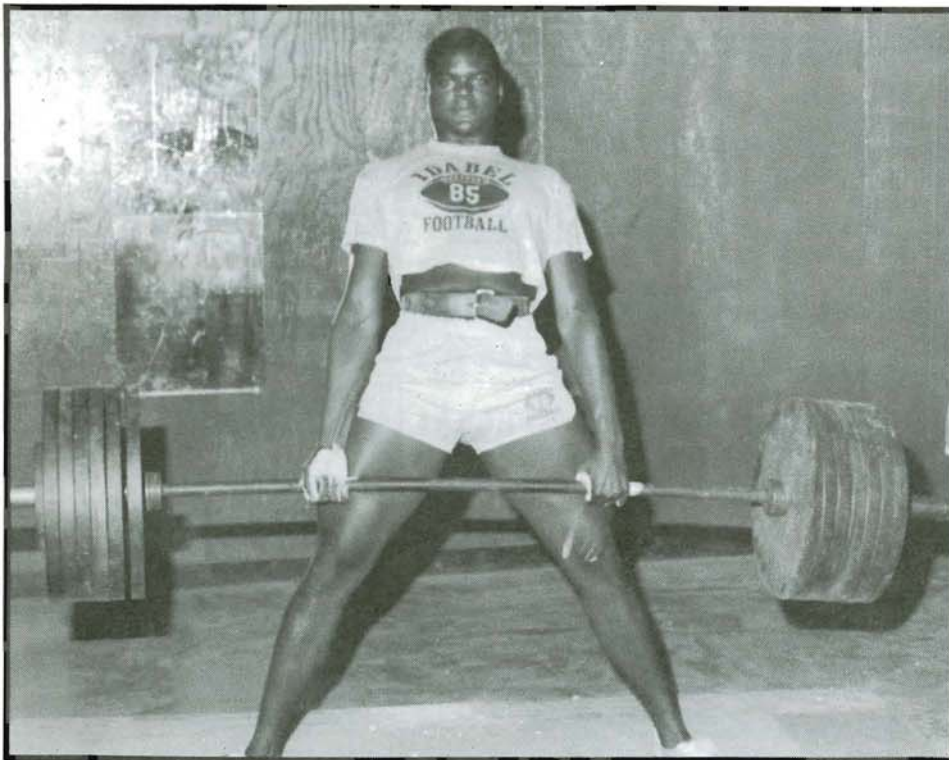

Mike Morphey 6-6 240

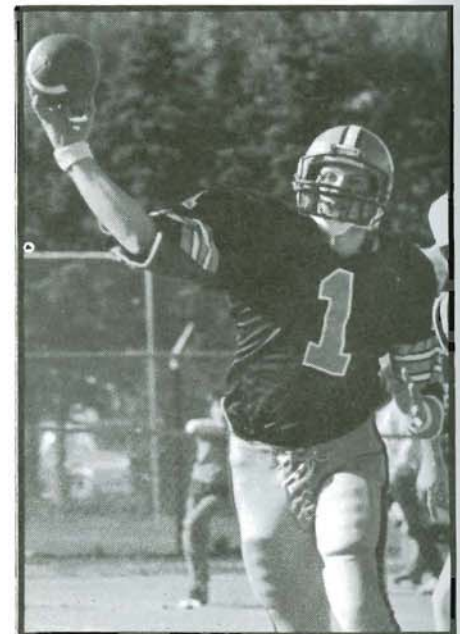
BFS All-American Special Mention
