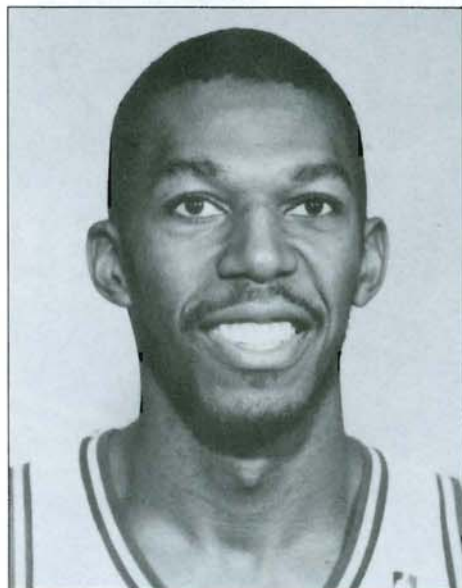


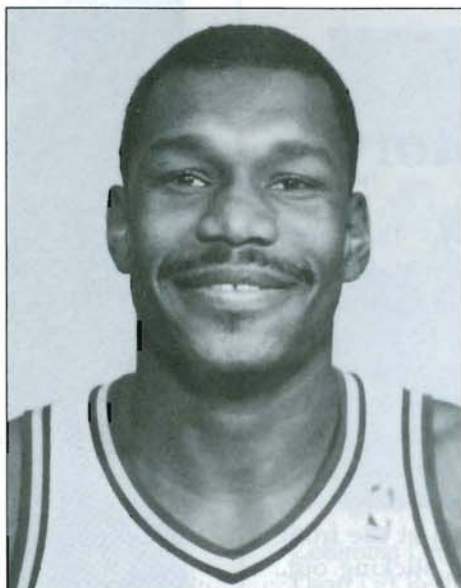
# THE 1988-89 UTAH JAZZ



**THURL BAILEY**

6-11 • 232 • Forward

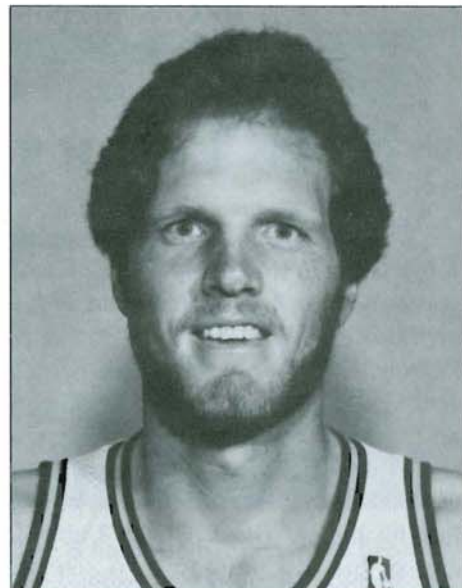
6th year with Utah. Made All-Rookie Team in 83-84. Jazz Career Playoff Scoring Leader. Won NBA Kennedy Citizenship Award this year. 1988-89 stats: 19.5 points per game, 91 blocked shots. #1 draft pick in 1983 after leading NC State to NCAA Title.



**MIKE BROWN**

6-10 • 260 • Forward/Center

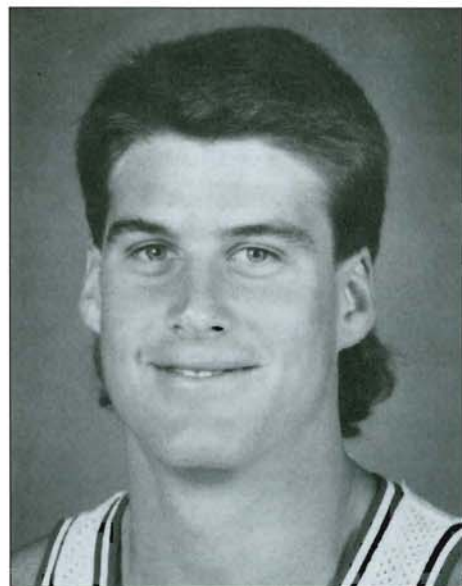
First year with Jazz, 3rd year as a pro. Second All-Time Leading scorer and rebounder at George Washington University. Earned college degree in 3 1/2 years. Averaged 4.5 points per game. An awesome rebounder.



**MARK EATON**

7-4 • 295 • Center

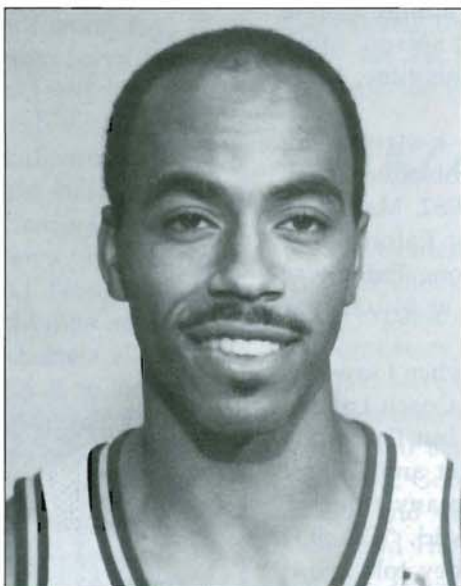
7th year with Utah. Jazz Top Career Rebounder. Moved up to 3rd in All-Time NBA Career Blocked Shots in 1989. Had most blocked shots in one game (14) this year in NBA. Played in 89 All-Star Game. NBA Top Ten 88-89 Rebounder.



**JIM FARMER**

6-5 • 220 • Guard/Forward

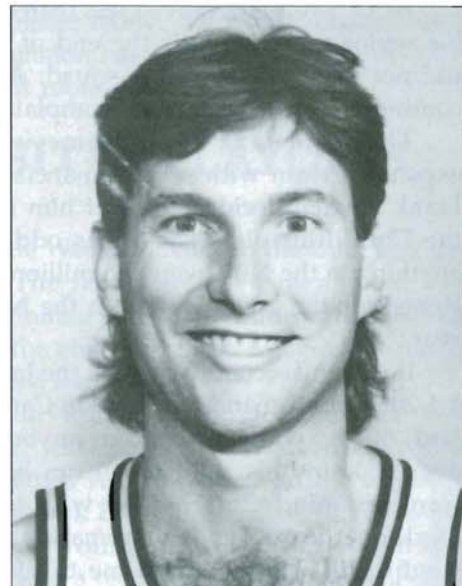
First year with Utah Jazz, played college ball at Alabama. Averaged 4.1 points per game in reserve role. Proved he can make big plays when it counts. A fearless competitor. Overcame broken hand injury this season.



**DARRELL GRIFFITH**

6-4 • 195 • Guard

Finished his 9th year with the Jazz. Was 1980-81 NBA Rookie-of-the-Year. Led NBA in 1983-84 Field Goal pct. Was 1980 College Player-of-the-year. Averaged 13.8 points this year and player in all 82 games after a serious foot injury.

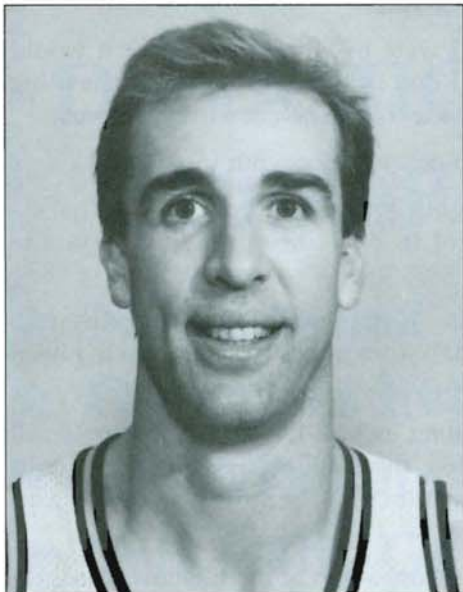


**BOBBY HANSEN**

6-6 • 195 • Guard

Finished 6th year with the Jazz. Has overcome a series of serious injuries, burns, and broken bones, on and off the court. Teams top 3-point shooter 1985-86. Averaged 7.4 points this year. Considered a top defensive player in the NBA.

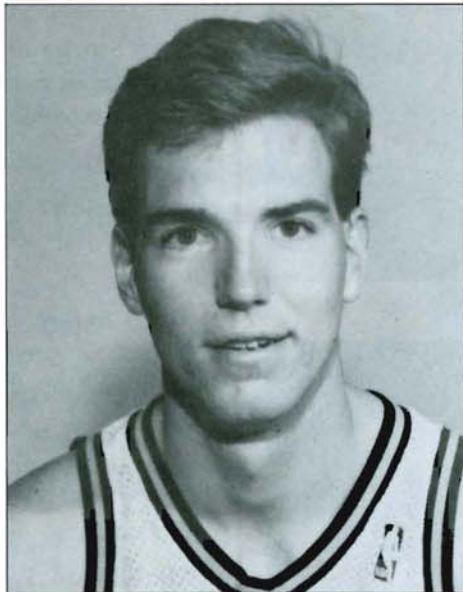
# MIDWEST CHAMPS



**MARK IAVARONI**

6-10 • 225 • Forward/Center

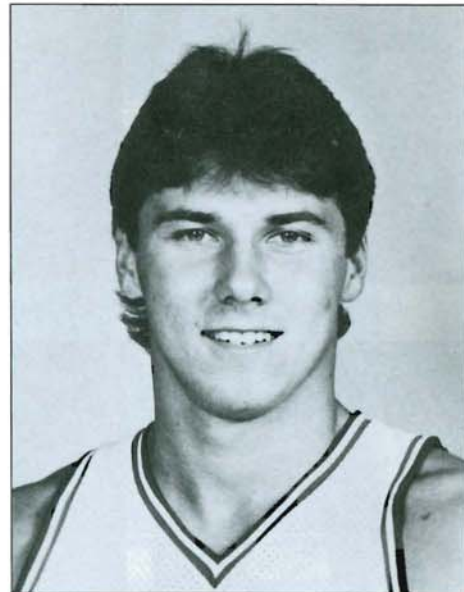
Finished 7th year as a Pro. Came to Jazz in 1986. Played 3 years in Italy and thus speaks fluent Italian. Extremely tenacious defender. Has seven years of playoff experience (most on team). Scored double figures all 4 years at Univ. of Virginia.



**ERIC LECKNER**

6-11 • 265 • Center

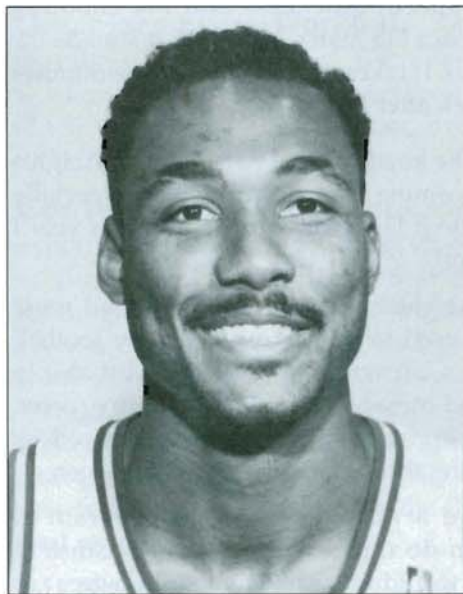
Just finished Rookie Year. Was #1 draft pick from Wyoming. Won WAC Tournament MVP 3 straight years. Has biggest hands on team. Scored 21 points in seasons last game. Had highest Field Goal Percentage on team.



**JIM LES**

6-0 • 170 • Guard

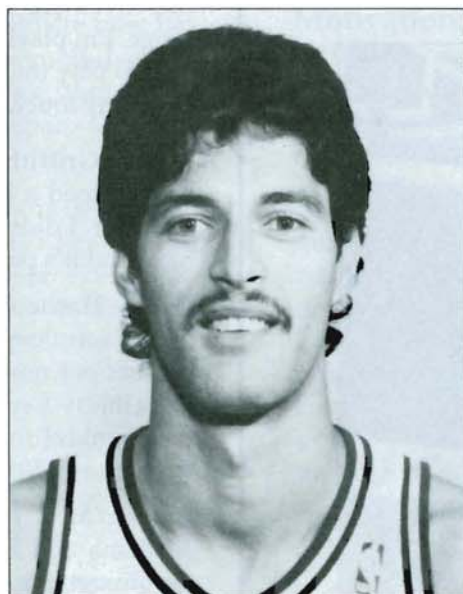
Just finished first year with Jazz. Has progressed steadily in back-up role to John Stockton. Had 215 assists for the season and played in all 82 games of the regular season. Also, had 27 steals for the season.



**KARL MALONE**

6-9 • 256 • Forward

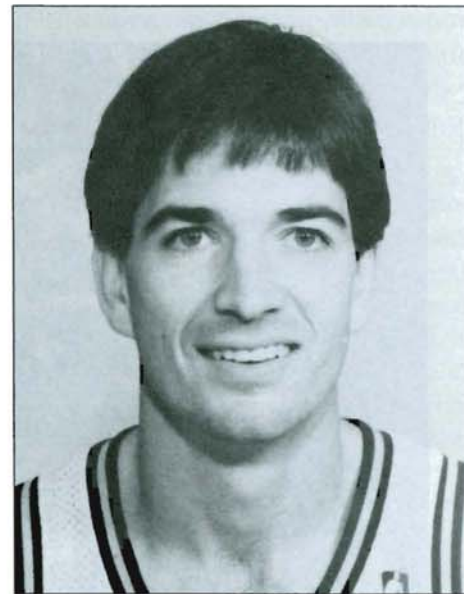
The Mailman delivered his best year in 1988-89. Just finished his 4th year with the Jazz at age 25. Karl was 2nd in NBA Scoring 29.1 average and fifth in Rebounding 10.7 average. Won the MVP All-Star Game Award.



**JOSE ORTIZ**

6-10 • 225 • Forward/Center

Just finished Rookie Year with Jazz. #1 Draft Pick from Oregon State in 1987 but sat out to represent Puerto Rico in the Olympics. Jose has added 20 pounds of solid weight during the season while reducing his body fat percent.



**JOHN STOCKTON**

6-1 • 175 • Guard

John was a surprise #1 Draft Pick in 1984. It was one of the great picks of the decade. John won the NBA Good Hands title easily for the 2nd year in a row. Led NBA in Assists and Steals, while scoring 17.1 a game. Best Free Throw % on the team.
