
Coach Spezia conducts a variety of basketball camps. In fact he has had over 20 years of summer camp experience. Basketball is not only in his blood but also must be in his bones, skin, brain and heart.

Coach Spezia was the NJCAA Division II Coach of the Year in 1991 and the NJCAA Region 24 Coach of the Year in 1991 & 1992. He has over 200 career wins and his teams are continually in the top 5 Free Throw Percentage teams nationally. He has coached four Academic All-Americans. Academics are a top priority for Coach Spezia. Freshmen need to have a 2.75 GPA on a 5.0 to meet NJCAA requirements. Most of the Jaguar players are far above that. Helping kids understand the importance of academics is considered by Spezia to part of his role as coach. "They're going to go someplace else," said Coach Spezia. "When they do, they'll step in

and not have a lot of problems. If they are up on basketball fundamentals and academics that helps your chances of being recruited."

Danville Area Community College is located in Danville, Illinois which is in the center of the state on the Indiana border. It is only 134 miles from Chicago and 86 miles from Indianapolis. The Danville area was home to Native Americans of the Woodland and Mississippi cultures between 500 and 1000 AD. As a result the county area boasts the largest acreage per capita of state and county public park tracts in the state of Illinois.
