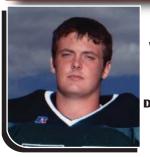

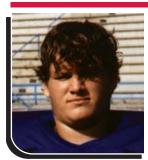

Milford HS, UT

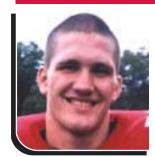
